Clue #4 What could the dog on the plaza be thinking about?

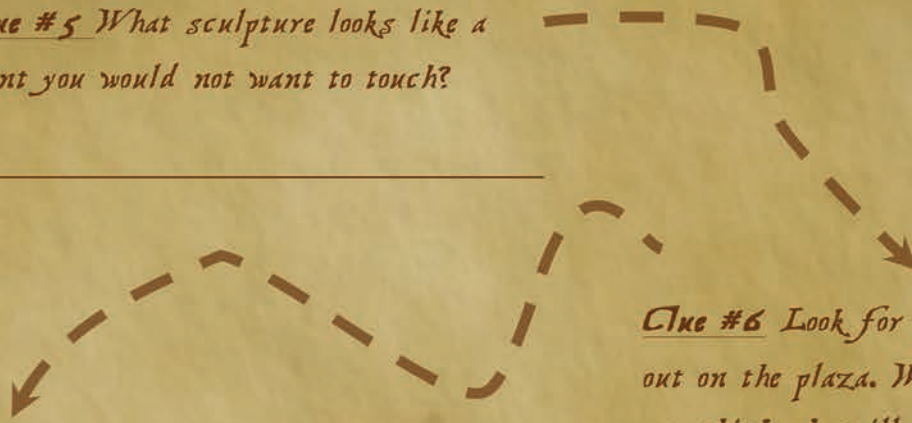

Clue #7 Look for the sculpture of a tree with many shapes in it. List all the different shapes you see.

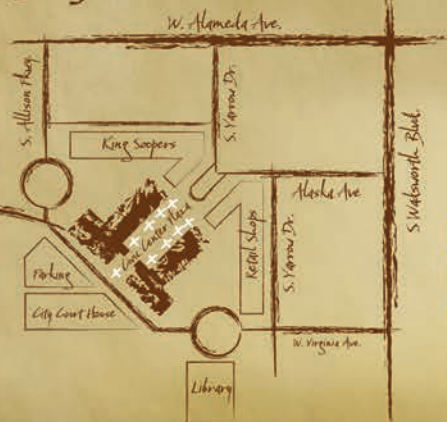


Clue #8 Find the eagle on the plaza with his feathers near his head. What does he make you think of?
